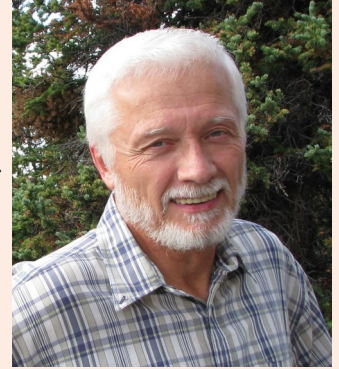


Your Tour Leaders
