SCINAP Peer-exchange event (20–24 February 2012)

From 20–24 February 2012, the SCINAP office in Dar es Salaam will be hosting a peer-exchange event to share information and experiences on solid waste management and urban agriculture among SCINAP programs in Dakar, Senegal, Dar es Salaam, Tanzania and Durban, South Africa. A number of local delegates will be participating in the event, including: members from each of the three municipal councils; the Dar es Salaam City Council (DCC); Ministry of Lands, Housing and Human Settlement Development (MLHHSD); as well as other local and international organizations and epistemological institutions involved in solid waste management and/or urban agriculture in Dar es Salaam.

We are also pleased to announce that we will be joined by members from the Mazingira Institute, located in Nairobi, Kenya. The Mazingira Institute "extends relevant knowledge and practices, promotes learning and cooperation and enhances ethical solidarity and advocacy" (www.mazinst.org). The Institute will be presenting on the Nairobi and Environs Food Security, Agriculture and Livestock Forum (NEFSALF).



Legitimization

We are also pleased to announce that Kinondoni Municipal Council has progressed to an advanced stage in the legitimization process. The municipality met with the MLHHSD last week and confirmed its intent to submit Strategic Plans on Urban Agriculture in time to be included in the New Master Plan for the City of Dar es Salaam. The documents will be submitted this week and the MLHHSD has agreed to approve them and incorporate them into the New Master Plan.

We are waiting for further feedback from Ilala Municipal Council and Temeke Municipal Council. We are striving to assist these municipalities in submitting their Strategic Plans to the MLHHSD in time for incorporation into the New Master Plan.
